
WE SAY NO!

To discrimination, abuse of power and sexual harassment

The relationships between students and instructors at art and music colleges are uniquely intimate and intense, especially in the context of individual teaching and small group work. And personal aspects such as emotional expression, charisma, and the body play a large role in performance and stage presence, whether you are an instrumentalist, a singer, or a dancer. Though developing these qualities is an essential part of artistic training, the close involvement it often requires is where personal boundaries can become blurry and behaviour can be ambiguous or intrusive.

This is true not only for interactions between students and faculty. Personal boundaries of individuals in our teaching, technology, and administration staff can also be violated.

What is more, people at the Hochschule für Musik und Tanz Köln come from many different cultures. Consequently, they do not always interpret situations in teaching and employment in the same way.

Where exactly personal boundaries lie and which words or actions might violate them are often hard to determine in advance. It always comes down to the subjective experience of individuals, and individuals must trust their own judgement.

- **Discrimination** begins when you feel demeaned by another's behaviour with regard to your person or outward appearance, leaving you feeling uncomfortable, inferior or uncertain.
- **Abuse of power** begins when you feel forced by an employer or any other person in a superior position to accept inappropriate behaviour or to behave in a certain way.
- **Sexual harassment** begins when you perceive another's statements, looks or gestures to be inappropriate, unpleasant or harassing in such a way that they violate your personal boundaries.


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What is sexual harassment?

- Lewd comments and sexually demeaning language
- Disparaging, sexist or sexually suggestive comments regarding a person's outward appearance, character, behaviour or intimate life
- Sharing comments, texts, or images with obscene, pornographic, or sexually demeaning content
- Unwanted touching or physical contact
- Stalking, sexual coercion, rape



What to do if you have experienced discrimination, abuse of power, or sexual harassment?

- State clearly that you find the behaviour or comments directed at you inappropriate.
- Seek help and talk with a person you trust.
 You have to right to receive counselling and file a complaint.
- Do not shy away from the possible negative consequences of filing a complaint. The university promises to stand behind you and provide protection.
- Note the time, place and circumstances of the incident or incidents. In this way, it will be easier to refer to specifics when discussing what happened to you.
